

The SkiWelt Wilder Kaiser - Brixental is celebrating its birthday and is not standing still, even after 45 years

Good news for the winter season 2022-23 in the SkiWelt Wilder Kaiser - Brixental

The mountain railways from six locations between Brixental and Wilder Kaiser merged in 1977: The SkiWelt Wilder Kaiser – Brixental was born. Not only are there two great new offers on occasion of the 45th birthday, but also 17.5 million Euro worth of investments.

INNOVATIONS

SkiWelt Ellmau - Going - mind-bogglingly sustainable

The expansion of the photovoltaic system on all roofs of the valley station, the mountain station, and the hotel complex in the SkiWelt Ellmau will save around 50% of energy costs in the building facilities in the future. In addition, the snowmaking system, and the pumping stations of the Hartkaiser reservoir will be expanded from 80,000 m3 to approx. 140,000 m3 as well as those of the Tanzboden reservoir from 125,000 m3 to approx. 160,000 m3. Furthermore, the pumping efficiency at the Hartkaiser will be increased from the current 280 lt/s to 780 lt/s and the cooling efficiency to 70%. A snow-making time of currently eight days is thus reduced to four days of full snowmaking, ensuring more operational reliability and security for the tourist region. In addition, the field-pipe system will be expanded by approx. 5.50 km, which means, larger pipes, a reduction in the flow rate and a renewal of the snow guns to a total of approx. 50 pieces.

SkiWelt Scheffau - mind-bogglingly sustainable

The SkiWelt Scheffau is focusing on improving and expanding the snow systems this year by purchasing new, energy-optimised snow guns and by merging the Scheffau and Brixen lakes. Also, a new winch machine has been purchased.

SkiWelt Söll - mind-bogglingly luxurious

A completely new "witchcraft" for connoisseurs, birthday children or romantics is the luxurious "champagne cable car". You can experience enjoyable moments with friends or family in the modern Hexenwasser (*witches' water*) cable car - either in the afternoon at 2:00 p.m. or in the evening from 6:30 p.m. For children there is the free treasure hunt "Ravens Rally" across the SkiWelt Söll.
