One of the largest ski-resorts in the world - and "mind-bogglingly sustainable"

45 years of SkiWelt - 20 years with green electricity

87 modern lifts, 270 kilometres of slopes and over 80 huts: SkiWelt Wilder Kaiser - Brixental is one of the largest ski-resorts in the world - and one of the most sustainable. For 20 years it has been powered by 100 percent green electricity from renewable hydropower.

Since 2002, **100 percent** of the electricity for **SkiWelt Wilder Kaiser - Brixental** has come **from hydroelectric power.** In recent years, **solar energy** has also been increasingly used: The "Sonnenlift" in Brixen, one of the first **completely solar powered** lifts in the world, has run on solar energy **since 2008**.

Conserving snow management

There are **15 reservoirs** in the SkiWelt for snowmaking, most of which are filled by snowmelt and precipitation. In spring, the melted snow is released naturally into the ground and emerges in the valley as pure Tyrolean drinking water. 65 snowmaking machines prepare the slopes in the SkiWelt every night – **GPS-controlled** for the last five years. This allows the snow to be distributed exactly where it is actually needed, saving over **20 percent** on costs and **water resources** in the past winters. **www.skiwelt.at**

Photovoltaics and waste heat

Photovoltaic modules are installed on more and more buildings and lifts (e.g. Jochlift and Zinsbergbahn Brixen, Brandstadl Scheffau) and, since spring 2022, on the valley and mountain stations of the **Ellmau cable car**. With 350 kilowatts peak, the systems can save up to 50 percent in external electricity and energy costs in the future. Also, **renewable energy** for the **heating** of company buildings is utilised more and more often in the SkiWelt. In addition to **pellets and biomass**, **waste heat** from lifts, snow guns and transformers is increasingly being used for heating with the help of **heat pumps** (Hochsöll, Brixen, Choralmbahn, Alpenrosenbahn Westendorf).
