New Gletscherexpress in Pitztal

The new Gletscherexpress in Pitztal has been in operation since mid-July 2022. It connects the Mittelberg valley station with the 2,840 m high mountain station on the Pitztal Glacier. The futuristic-looking funicular with eight compartments runs on electricity from the Pitztal Glacier's photovoltaic system. An information system provides passengers with updates and live images from the journey.

New Hornbahn lift and observation tower in the Ski Juwel Alpbachtal Wildschönau

The Ski Juwel Alpbachtal Wildschönau ski area is celebrating its tenth anniversary in 2022. To mark the occasion – and to offer its guests even more comfort – the valley is replacing the Hornlift 2000 with a detachable 6-seater chairlift with weather protection hoods and heated seats. The new Hornbahn will go into operation at the beginning of the winter season 2022/23. Having reached the top, skiers will find a modern mountain station with the "Top of Alpbachtal" observation tower.

New 10-seater gondola in Axamer Lizum

From winter 2022/23, it will take winter sports enthusiasts in Axamer Lizum just six minutes to reach the 2,340 m Hoadl sunny plateau from the car park. A new 10-seater gondola with two sections will replace the Schönboden and Hoadl I+II chairlifts. The new valley station includes a shop and ski rental. The construction of a hydroelectric power plant on the Axamer Bach is also planned. The electricity generated there could cover the needs of the Axamer Lizum systems to a large extent.

Leppleskofelbahn in the Defereggental ski centre

East Tirol's highest cable car system will open in St. Jakob im Defereggental in December 2022. The new 6-seater Leppleskofel chairlift with heated seats and weather protection hoods leads from the valley station of the former Almspitz lift up to 2,683 m above sea level. At the same time, three new slopes will be opened in time for the winter season, making the St. Jakob ski area in the Defereggental even more attractive.

New Kühtaile 6-seater chairlift in the Hochoetz ski area

The family-friendly Hochoetz ski area in the Ötztal is characterised by its guaranteed snow, many viewpoints and great number of sunny days. From winter 2022/23, skiers will be able to reach the top of the mountain even more comfortably and quickly. The new Kühtaile 6-seater chairlift, equipped with a child lock and boarding conveyor belt, replaces the previous 3-seater chairlift.

The new 8-seater Furglerblick gondola will go into operation in the family-friendly See ski area in the Paznaun Valley at the beginning of the winter season 2022/23. It will take skiers to an altitude of 2,570 m and thus directly to the start of a new blue run with a length of 1.2 km. The new gondola will not just expand the offer for winter sports enthusiasts, but also free up the ski area's 4-seater chairlift.

From winter 2022/23, skiers will be able to access the Gerlos ski area more comfortably from the slopes near Zell am Ziller. The new Kapauns 8-seater chairlift with an extended route replaces the 2-seater chairlift. It is equipped with weather protection hoods and heated seats. In the next construction phase, which should be completed by winter 2023/24, the Krimml X-Press will be renewed.

Construction work has been underway on the Asitzkogel, Leogang's local mountain since April 2022. The resort is part of the Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn. The new Asitzkogelbahn is due to go into operation at the beginning of the 2022/23 winter season. The 8-person chairlift will shorten any waiting times and offer plenty of comfort. It is equipped with heated seats, protective hoods, and automatic restraining bars. The new lift replaces the 6-seater L7 Sportbahn.

Gondola on the Galsterberg

On the Galsterberg, a popular family ski area in the Schladming-Dachstein region, the new Galsterbergbahn will go into operation in December 2022. The 10-person gondola with individual upholstered seats replaces the 30-year-old group gondola lift, which will increase transport capacity and comfort significantly. The valley and mountain stations are also being rebuilt with wooden shingle facades establishing a connection to the region.

Combination lift and high-altitude trail on the Rittisberg

A new combined lift equipped with gondolas and 6-seater chairs will open on the Rittisberg near Ramsau in the Schladming-Dachstein region at the beginning of winter, replacing the 4-seater chairlift. With this new lift the Rittsibergbahn operators are expanding their offer for non-skiers. From this winter, a 5.5 km long high-altitude trail will be accessible. A path for winter hikers and snowshoe hikers runs parallel to the trail, unveiling breath-taking views of the Dachstein and the Ennstal time and again along the way.

The new, 450 m long Wörthersee-Freeride-Jet will go into operation on the southeast side of the Gerlitzen Alpe in December 2022. The 4-seater chairlift is replacing a button lift, making it easier for ski and snowboard beginners to get to this side of the mountain. The new lift is also ideal for freeriders. It leads directly to the starting point of natural snow descents such as the Finsterbach freeride slopes.

A new building will open on the Mühlviertler Alm by the Liebenau ski lift at the start of the winter season 2022/23. There are already twelve AlpenParks Apartment & Holiday Resorts in Austria. Consistently sustainable: Heuberg1014

On the Heuberg, just above Schwarzenberg in the Bregenzerwald, the Feurstein family has rebuilt "Heuberg1014" with a firm focus on sustainability. The building, which will open for guests at the beginning of the 2022/23 winter season, is made of exposed concrete and wood, some of which comes from the nearby forest. Some of the furniture was even crafted out of the forest's own maple wood by a carpenter from the Bregenzerwald. Plates and bowls were made by hand as part of a local social project. The heating uses geothermal energy and electricity is supplied by a photovoltaic system. "Heuberg1014" has six holiday apartments. The small ones are suitable for one to two guests and the largest offers space for up to twelve guests.
