INNSBRUCK – Alpine-Urban Flair with a Touch of Thrill

Between culture and nature, city and mountains, tradition and trends - no other region and city combines extreme opposites in such a charming way as Innsbruck. Here you can travel from the heart of the Tyrolean state capital to lofty heights on the **Nordkette** in just 20 minutes to experience the Alpine jewel up close and marvel at the pulsating activity from above. For the not-so-faint-at-heart, we will get to sit on the official starting bar of the **Olympic Bergisel Ski Jump**, and then let the pros actually take off and jump!

Journey 2

ÖTZTAL – Of Spies and Spas

If you are looking for an epic arc in your day from lounging on Alpine pastures and delighting in delicacies on Alpine huts to James Bond like thrills and push-your-limits bike trails, you have found your place in the Ötztal (Ötz Valley). The **James Bond 007 Elements** exhibit is built inside a mountain summit, and if so inspired, you want to challenge your own inner daredevil, we invite you to join **Bike Republic Sölden** – a one of a kind bike park for all levels! And there is no better way to relax than at the architecturally stunning **Aqua Dome spa**, admiring the mountains that we conquered from a hot tub.

Journey 3

ST. JOHANN IN TIROL – 6000 Bottles of Wine at 4000 Feet

This Baroque town invites you to stroll, linger and enjoy yourself but also thanks to its central location **between the Kitzbüheler Horn and the Wilder Kaiser** mountains, the town is an ideal starting point for all kinds of tours to explore also the exceptional culinary offerings in the mountains! From a brewery to a mountain pine oil distillery to an exceptional wine cellar at 4000 feet at **Angerer Alm** where we will also spend a night after being treated to a gourmet dinner!

Journey 4

ZELL AM SEE – KAPRUN – Glaciers, Mountains, Lake, and 4 Climate Zones

In this unique natural paradise at the edge of the Hohe Tauern National Park sports enthusiasts, active holidaymakers, families and those seeking relaxation will discover a wide range of experiences yearround. The guided **Kitzsteinhorn Explorer Tour** with a Nationalpark Ranger will take us over 4 climate zones from 2358 to 9087 feet (with the help of a panorama gondola) for a summit hike and summit breakfast. We will learn about **High Alpine water reservoirs** that are supplying sustainable electricity from the runoff from surrounding mountains and glaciers, and afterwards we can cool off with a swim in the crystal-clear waters of Lake Zell.
