Get away from it all at Hotel Eriro Alpine Hide in Ehrwald in Tirol, where many of the architectural elements and furnishings are crafted by hand and made of natural materials. The charmingly renovated Hotel Schwarzes Rössl by Lake Wolfgangsee in Upper Austria, on the other hand, delights guests with its retro chic design.

Those interested in culture will be toasting the 200th birthday of "Waltz King" Johann Strauss in Vienna in 2025, whilst 60 years of "The Sound of Music" will be celebrated in Salzburg. And at the S-MAK in Lustenau you can learn more about the past and present of Vorarlberg embroidery.

Sustainability and environmental awareness are becoming ever more important. Many establishments are investing in photovoltaic systems. Regions and cities are offering environmentally friendly mobility concepts such as the new free Burgenland Card or the 7-day Vienna City Card.



Yes, it still exists: winter in all its facets. With thick snow and distant views, with an adrenaline rush on the black slope and apple strudel by the warm stove, with hearty snowball fights, red cheeks and children's laughter echoing down the toboggan run. The sun-drenched **Seefeld region** invites you to go cross-country skiing and snowshoeing, whilst the **Tirol-**West holiday region around Landeck caters for the active, nature lovers and families alike with leisurely ski tours to alpine pastures or husky treks through the untouched Kaunergrat Nature Park. A further tip for explorers is the Nature Watch Tour in Karwendel Nature Park near Hall-Wattens. Over on the sunny side of the Alps in Carinthia, wide mountain landscapes entice you to head out on winter hikes and frozen lakes to glide across the ice on skates. The next ski area is never far away and there are fantastic cross-country skiing opportunities too. Enjoy a break in the heart of nature and authentic winter delights with a holiday on a farm or at Austria's hiking hotels. Alternatively, experience the charming Advent season in Salzburg, Graz or **Innsbruck** where you are also close to the mountains.

Piste and powder. Active and enjoyable mountain holidays

Wide slopes to carve down, cool snowparks for freestylers and breathtaking powder runs for deep snow fanatics: live your winter dream at Austria's renowned ski resorts. In addition to the variety of slopes, old and new wooden architecture and the local culinary delights add to the appeal of the Bregenzerwald in Vorarlberg. Nearby Montafon enchants with the silence of the high mountains on guided ski tours and snow-sure slopes until spring. St. Anton am Arlberg stands out with its direct train connection and diverse alpine ski area. This can also be found in the winter sports paradise of Zillertal, where family mountains and powder areas reach up to glacier level. Fun on the Ski amadé slopes before diving into warm thermal waters: that's winter in Altenmarkt-Zauchensee. An exclusive ski and spa break in the legendary thermal spa town of Bad Gastein is promised by Travel Charme Hotel Badeschloss and the Straubinger Grand Hotel. Those looking for a more casual and sustainable vibe will love the Explorer Hotels in Austria's top winter sports resorts.

Relaxing family time. Ski, snow and fun with extras

Children and snow are a match made in heaven. Many winter sports regions offer inexpensive children's ski courses and professional childcare. Sports and relaxation await you on and off the slopes in the Tirolean holiday region of Serfaus-Fiss-Ladis, one of Austria's most family-friendly ski resorts. Families who like to ski will also find themselves in their element in Radstadt, the "Old Town in the Mountains" south of Salzburg, whilst cross-country skiing fans can look forward to high-altitude trails with a view and rustic huts for those all-important breaks along the way. The Styrian region of Murau scores with its family-friendly ski areas and toboggan runs; even BERGaufRODELN (uphill tobogganing) is possible here. In the Sun Ski World Nassfeld-Pressegger See in Carinthia, extras such as safe practice areas, race tracks for pros and plenty of hours of sunshine win guests over. And the Aldiana Clubs and JUFA Hotels prove that ski holidays do not have to be expensive in Austria with their ski pass inclusive offers.

Climate-conscious travel by train

Deutsche Bahn's WinterRail offers are the affordable, comfortable and eco-friendly way to get to Austria's slopes. Tickets are available from 37.90 euros, and from 19.90 euros for short distances (e.g. Munich-Tirol). Children up to 15 years even travel free of charge with an accompanying person (from 15 years of age). Bookings for journeys from Switzerland can be made via SBB or ÖBB. Shuttles, public and regional transport can be used to get around locally and are usually included in the guest cards.





New slopes on the Gerlitzen

From winter 2024/25 a new downhill run and the Gerlitzen Skiline Speed Check will be adding to the appeal of the Gerlitzen Alpe above Lake Ossiach. The newly created Alpenrosen run leads to the middle station. As a blue slope it's an easier alternative to the existing red ones. The Gerlitzen Skiline Speed Check will open near the Feuerberg run, giving skiers the opportunity to measure their speed. Daredevils can download their photo with speed information in the Skiline app as a souvenir and proof of their rapid ride.

Better signage for ski tourers

The Gerlitzen Alpe ski area offers several routes for ski tourers that lead uphill along the edge of the pistes and back down on marked slopes. New signage will make it easier to follow the routes from this winter. Popular tours include the ascent along the Klösterle run, on which ski tourers overcome around 900 m in altitude. Upon reaching the summit the 6.7 km long run leads back down to the valley.

New ski season ticket in Lower Austria

Ten ski resorts in Lower Austria will be offering a joint season ticket from winter 2024/25. It will be valid for ski areas including those on the Hochkar, the Ötscher, the Semmering and the Erlebnisalm Mönichkirchen. The earlier you buy the ticket, the cheaper it is. It offers particularly great value for families, with each adult season ticket including a child up to the age of 10. When buying two adult season tickets, a child up to the age of 15 is included.

Wintersportarena Liebenau: snowmaking for cross-country ski trails

Thanks to the construction of a second reservoir the cross-country ski trails can now be supplied with snow in addition to the ski slopes.

As of this winter two new SkiMovie routes on the Asitz in the Saalfelden-Leogang ski area will show who's fastest. Keen racers begin their descent from the start hut. One of the new SkiMovie routes is located by the 8-seater Asitzgipfel lift at the junction of slope 215 near the NITRO Snowpark. The other is located at the Steinberg lift in the lower area of slope 211.

Alpine race training in the Zillertal

The Hochfügen ski lift company in the Zillertal will be opening its new Racepoint for ski clubs with the launch of the 2024/25 winter season. This means that ski racers will be able to train for slalom and giant slalom on piste 8, which is recognised and approved by the FIS (Fédération Internationale de Ski), as early as late autumn. The slope is located at a snow-sure altitude of 1,500 to 1,700 m and around 800 m long. Safety nets, starting ramps and tower cannons including water connections for snowmaking ensure safe and effective training.





Panoramic hiking trail

From the end of October 2024 a new panoramic hiking trail through the Lake Neusiedl UNESCO Whererld Heritage Site will connect the loveliest destinations in the municipalities of Donnerskirchen, Purbach, Breitenbrunn, Winden and Jois. The trail covers a total of around 27 km and can be easily divided into stages. The excellent train and bus connections mean you can begin anywhere along the way. Highlights include the mountain church in Donnerskirchen, vineyards, historic town centres and natural phenomena such as dry grasslands and rare animal and plant species. New information boards along the way display interesting facts about nature, culture and traditions.

Longest glacier trail reopened

The cross-country ski trail on the Dachstein glacier will reopen this winter. Depending on snow conditions the trail can be up to 15 km long, making it the longest glacier trail in the world. At an altitude of 2,700 m it not only offers excellent conditions for recreational cross-country skiers, but also serves as a training location for professional athletes before competitions. From autumn to spring the conditions here are at their very best. The route covers up to 1.5 km of diagonal and skating trails.

Snowshoe route Dias in Kappl

There will be a new snowshoe walking trail in Kappl in the Paznaun from this winter. The 1.8 km long route is signposted and climbs 77 vertical metres through the idyllic, wintry mountain landscape. The moderately difficult trail begins at the mountain station of the Diasbahn. A quietly situated wooden barn is the ideal place to take a break on the way. The trail then leads back to the mountain station and Sunny Mountain Restaurant along the same route.

A new 10 km long snowshoe hiking route will expand the offer for keen hikers in the Pitztal from this winter. The route leads from Weiler Plangeroß to Mittelberg, but can be shortened by choosing an earlier exit point. It is continuously monitored by the avalanche commission and closed if deemed unsafe.




Vienna City Card for 7 days

Tröglbahn Nassfeld

A 6-seater chairlift is replacing the previous 4-seater on Nassfeld's slopes in the south of Carinthia. From December 2024 the new Tröglbahn will transport skiers up the mountain much faster than before. The barrier-free chairlift is equipped with weather protection hoods, heated seats, conveyor belt and bar lock. Bergbahnen Nassfeld are also expanding the ski depot at the valley station of the Millennium-Express. The company is investing heavily to optimise energy consumption too. The new mountain station of the Tröglbahn will be equipped with a photovoltaic system and new snow-making equipment consumes around 20% less energy. Bergbahnen Nassfeld have been covering their energy needs from renewable energy sources such as hydro and wind power, solar energy, biogas and biomass since 2016.

Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn: 12er NORD and 10-seater single-cable gondola lift

Two new lifts will go into operation this winter in the resort of Skicircus Saalbach Hinterglemm Leogang Fieberbrunn, which stretches across the provinces of SalzburgerLand and Tirol. In Hinterglemm the stand-up gondola lift from 1989 will be replaced by the new 12er NORD, a single-cable gondola lift with ten seats in each cabin. The new valley station will be accessible via a modern ski bridge that will provide direct access to the 12er NORD and also to the Hochalmbahn. In Fieberbrunn the new 10-seater single-cable gondola lift Streubödenbahn will transport passengers faster, more comfortably and directly to the Lärchfilzkogel from December 2024. The new lift replaces the 33-year-old Streuböden and Lärchfilzkogel lifts and takes skiers to the mountain station without having to change. What's also unique about the new Streubödenbahn is the fact that it was financed by crowdfunding, with contributions from locals and guests.

Loser Panoramabahn

Since September 2024 visitors have been able to take the new gondola lift up the Loser at Lake Altaussee. The new lift replaces the 6-seater Loser Jet chairlift and the 2-seater Loser 2 chairlift. The cabins are barrier-free and there is also room for buggies and mountain bikes inside. In winter the new gondola lift will take skiers directly to the lifts on the Loser Plateau. In summer it is the environmentally friendly alternative to travelling along the panoramic road by car. The new gondola lift is expected to help save around 30,000 car journeys each summer.

New lifts in the Schladming-Dachstein region

From December 2024 the new 10-seater Rohrmoos I gondola lift will replace the previous 2-seater chairlift. It connects Schladming with the beginner's area in Rohrmoos and improves the connection to the Planai/Hochwurzen ski area. What's new is that skiers will be able to transport their skis inside the 30 panorama gondolas, making it quicker to get on and off and also easier for families with small children. The new Planai West valley station is within walking distance of Schladming. It has a lounge area with bar, sports shop and ski depots, plus escalators and an elevator to simplify entry and exit. From December 2024 the new 8-seater high-speed Kaiblinggrat chairlift will also begin taking guests to the top of the Hauser Kaibling. It replaces a 4-seater chairlift and has a significantly higher transport capacity.
